To review all submissions of Emergency Nursing Practice issues forwarded to the committee by Emergency Nursing in Canada.

To respond to individual nurses, or groups, who present to us specific issues related to Emergency Nursing.

The membership will consist of all Board Members inclusive of executive and provincial directors.
