NENA Bursaries

NENA recognizes the need to promote excellence in Emergency care and to this end, will provide financial assistance to its members. NENA will budget for a predetermined amount of monies annually for the support of ongoing education with the mandate of facilitating a high standard of Emergency patient care throughout Canada.

All members of NENA are eligible for consideration for these bursaries if the criteria are met.

All NENA Bursaries will be valued at \$500 CDN except the Provincial Bursary is \$1000 CDN

Regular Bursaries are awarded based on the number of provincial, territorial or independent members calculated by the Bursary Committee as of March 31st annually.

There are up to a maximum of 5 bursaries for International Delegates to an international Emergency nursing conference, either as an attendee, or a delegate.

There are 10 ENC(C) Bursaries are available annually for members: 5 for NENA members writing their initial certification exam and 5 for members who are recertifying their ENC(C).

Annually there is one "Margaret Smith Memorial Bursary" one "Deb Cotton Memorial Bursary", and one "Provincial Bursary" each with their specific criteria.

All Bursaries are to be applied for on the nena.ca website. Applications must be received no later than March 31st.

Completed applications and applicable documentation will be reviewed by the Bursary/Awards Committee. Selections will be made according to the selection process outlined in the NENA Bursary Policy.

NENA Nursing Research Grants are available through a different application process and under the guidance of the Director of Education and Learning and the Research Committee, information will be on nena.ca
