Background

NENA encourages all of its members to obtain CNA Emergency Nursing Certification –Canada (ENC(C)). This certification promotes expertise in the specialty and assists Registered Nurses to keep current with emergency nursing knowledge and practice. Currently more than 1100 Emergency Registered Nurses across Canada have their national ENC(C) designation.

For NENA members writing this certification exam for the first time, NENA will award 5-\$750 bursaries annually.

For NENA members re-certifying their certification through writing the exam or through continuous learning activities, NENA will award 5- \$750 bursaries annually.

Eligibility

- Current NENA membership for a minimum of 6 months.
- Application and writing of the certification exam, or recertifying in the current certification year.

Applicants must complete Bursary Application on-line at nena.ca, indicating that they are applying for an ENC(C) Bursary.

Applications must be received by March 31st

Selection of bursary recipients will be made by the Bursary Selection Facilitator according to the selection process outlined in the Bursary Selection Policy.
