Guidelines for Presentation Abstracts:

1. Submissions:

- The deadline for submissions is **December 15, 2025**.
- This proposal may have been previously presented at another event.
- Abstract selection is a peer review process by the NENA National Conference 2026 Committee. Successful presenters will be notified by **January 15, 2026**, and must indicate their commitment to attend by **February 2, 2026**.

2. Format:

- Abstracts are to be written in English. The abstract is **limited to 500 words or less** and should describe the central theme of the presentation.
- Your abstract should include the following:
 - Title
 - Background
 - Objective(s)
 - Methods/Implementation
 - Evaluation/Results
 - Implications/Advice & Lessons Learned

- A cover page must include the abstract title, the author(s) name(s), credentials, current position, address, email address and phone number for correspondence. Please indicate one of the following areas your topic pertains to: clinical practice, education, innovative solutions, advocacy, case studies, research, injury prevention.
- Presentations will be **30 to 60 minutes** in length, including questions (indicate presentation time preference in submission)
- Abstracts must be submitted by email in Microsoft Word formatting to:

Guidelines for Poster Presentations:
